

## Walk 9

### Mere Way

3 miles

1. Leave Impington village alongside Milton Road past the now Parish Council owned red telephone box and join the cycle/footpath alongside the road. The road and path bends right (Butt Lane, but no sign!). Carry on along this path for 3/4 mile. After passing the "Evolution Business Park" and a row of modern cottages turn right onto a Public Byway signed as Mere Way towards Cambridge Regional College.
2. Mere Way is an old Roman Road that once linked Cambridge with the Isle of Ely. After one mile the track merges with a metaled road and continues by a bridge under the A14. Be careful on the short road section as it is the access to the adjacent travellers' site. Note the suitable appropriate artwork on the western abutment of the A14 bridge: modern cave paintings!
3. Immediately after the bridge, take the gravel Byway to your right (before you reach the CRC car park). After around 100 yards the path turns left and you will see the guard rails at the end marking the junction with the guided busway. At the busway turn to your right and you will arrive back in Impington after one mile.

This entire route is suitable (in dry weather) and legal to cycle - time about 30 minutes.
