

Walk 8

The Coppice via Guided Busway and Orchard Park, Cambridge - circular walk

3.5 miles

1. Start at the Railway Vue pub. Turn left and walk along the guided busway under the road bridge, going past the back of Histon Recreation Ground on the left and then the lake on the right hand side. Continue underneath the A14.
2. Turn right at the guided busway junction and then immediately right after the bus stop by the cycle racks onto Starr End, which then becomes Topper Street (at the junction with Flack End).
3. Walk along Topper Street (past the junction with Grafham Road on the left) and round a left hand and then a right hand bend past a play area on the right, then past Neil Drive on the right.
4. At the junction with Chieftain Way, walk almost straight across the junction into Stanley Avenue. Walk past a Community Centre on the left hand side and this straight road then becomes Central Avenue.
5. As the road bends to the right take a left hand path and walk to the traffic lights 50 yards to the left – this is the junction of Kings Hedges Road and Arbury Road.
6. Cross the road straight across into Arbury Road. Immediately walk past another set of traffic lights and walk about 100 yards – St Albans Recreation Ground is on the right.
7. When outside St Albans Primary School, turn right into St Albans Road.
8. Walk along St Albans Road to the T-junction with Roseford Road.
9. Turn right onto Roseford Road. Walk along to the junction with Histon Road.
10. Turn right into Histon Road.
11. Walk straight along Histon Road and past the traffic lights at the junction with Kings Hedges Road.
12. Walk straight over at the A14 roundabout towards Histon.
13. Immediately turn left into Cambridge Road at the traffic lights. Then after about 30 yards turn right at the junction and continue along Cambridge Road back to the starting point at the Railway Vue.
